**ADMINISTRATIVE CIRCULAR NO. 111 DATE 01/06/2007**

Sub : Revised format of '*No Objection Certificate*' for Passport purpose.

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The erstwhile Maharashtra State Electricity Board, had issued instructions/guidelines vide above referred Circulars and Administrative Circulars regarding issuance of '*No Objection Certificate*' to the employees who desire to obtain Indian Passport from Passport Authorities.

2. Recently Government of India, Ministry of External Affairs, has issued the revised format of '*No Objection Certificate*' to be issued by the employer to the employees working with Central/State Government/Public Sector/Undertaking/Statutory Bodies etc.

3. In view of the above changes, the '*No Objection Certificate*' is now required to be issued in duplicate on original stationary. The prescribed revised format of the NOC along with a copy of Section 5(2)c and Section 6(2) of Indian Passport Act, 1967 is enclosed for ready reference.

4. All the concerned authorities are requested to note the changes, while issuing the '*No Objection Certificate*' to the employees who desire to obtain the Indian Passport from Passport Authorities

5. The other terms and conditions of the Circulars mentioned above shall remain unchanged.

6. This Administrative Circular comes into force with immediate effect.

## THE PASSPORTS ACT, 1967

### Section 5. Applications for passports, travel documents, etc., and orders thereon

2 (c) refuse to issue the passport or travel document or, as the case may be, refuse to make on the passport or travel document any endorsement.

### Section 6. Refusal of passports, travel documents. etc.

- (2) Subject to the other provisions of this Act, the passport authority shall refuse to issue a passport or travel document for visiting any foreign country under clause (c) of sub-section (2) of section 5 on any one or more of the following grounds, and on no other ground, namely: -
- (a) that the applicant is not a citizen of India.,
  - (b) that the applicant may, or is likely to, engage outside India in activities prejudicial to the sovereignty and integrity of India.;
  - (c) that the departure of the applicant from India may, or is likely to, be detrimental to the security of India;
  - (d) that the presence of the applicant outside India may, or is likely to, prejudice the friendly relations of India with any foreign country;
  - (e) that the applicant has, at any time during the period of five years immediately preceding the date of his application, been convicted by a court in India for any offence involving moral turpitude and sentenced in respect thereof to imprisonment for not less than two years;
  - (f) that proceedings in respect of an offence alleged to have been committed by the applicant are pending before a criminal court in India;
  - (g) that a warrant or summons for the appearance, or a warrant for the arrest, of the applicant has been issued by a court under any law for the time being in force or that an order prohibiting the departure from India of the applicant has been made by any such court;
  - (h) that the applicant has been repatriated and has not reimbursed the expenditure incurred in connection with such repatriation;
  - (i) that in the opinion of the Central Government the issue of a passport or travel document to the applicant will
