# ADMINISTRATIVE CIRCULAR NO. 242 DATE 27/08/2009

Sub: Revision of existing rates of allowances.

The Board of Directors under its Resolution No. 872 Dated 12/08/2009 have decided to revise the existing rates of allowances with retrospective effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2008 for the employees upto the rank of Dy. Executive Engineers whose minimum pay scale is Rs. 9890/- per month. The details are as under:-

#### iv) Transport Assistance Allowance

As per the provisions of G.O. 122 (P) dated 22/03/1990, the employees whose place of working is situated within the jurisdiction of Municipal Corporation including urban agglomeration areas are entitled to this allowance. Now, this provision has been extended to the employees upto the level of Dy. Executive Engineer and its equivalent working in other than Muncipal Corporation area also. The existing rate of allowance of Rs.45/- per month is revised to Rs. 100/-per month.
