CIRCULAR

Sub : Staff Welfare Fund  
Scheme of cash prizes and scholarship for  
the sons and daughters of the Board's  
employees.

Ref : This office circular No. LIR/B/SWF/21096  
dated 21-5-1976.

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The Staff Welfare Fund Committee in its 5th meeting held 29-11-1976 has decided to increase the amount as also the number of cash prizes and scholarships to be awarded to the sons and daughters of the Board's employees during the academic year 1976-77.

The total number of cash prizes for the whole State have been increased from 18 to 30 so that now 10 cash prizes will be awarded in each regional area of Western Maharashtra, Vidarbha and Marathwada. Similarly the total number of scholarships have been increased from 36 to 45 so that 15 scholarships will be awarded in each region of Western Maharashtra, Vidarbha and Marathwada. The value of the first cash prize is increased to Rs.125/- and the amount of each scholarship has been increased from Rs.25/- to Rs.40/- per month.

The details of the cash prizes and scholarships to be awarded during the academic year are as under :-

- a) 5 prizes, each of the value of Rs.125/-, Rs.100/-, Rs.75/-, Rs.50/- and Rs.25/- to those ranking 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th from amongst the sons and daughters of the employees of Pay Gr. I & II from the regions of Western Maharashtra, Vidarbha and Marathwada.
- b) 5 prizes each of the value of Rs.125/-, Rs.100/-, Rs.75/-, Rs.50/- and Rs.25/- to those ranking 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th from amongst the sons and daughters of the Pay Group III & IV employees from the regions of Western Maharashtra, Vidarbha and Marathwada.

The cash prizes of Rs.50/- and Rs.25/- are primarily reserved for the sons/daughters of the employees belonging to schedule caste/schedule tribes who pass the S.S.C. or equivalent examination irrespective of the marks obtained and in case such candidates are not available then prizes will be awarded to other candidates as per the merit list prepared on the basis of the applications received.

- c) Qualifying marks for eligibility of prizes will be a minimum of 60% marks in respect of prizes under 'a' and 50% in respect of prizes under 'b' above.

The Committee also decided to increase the total number of scholarships from 36 to 45 and the amount of each scholarship to be increased to Rs.40/- instead of Rs.25/- p.m. as decided earlier. The scholarships will be awarded to the sons/daughters of Board employees belonging to Pay Group III & IV. In all 5 scholarships will be awarded to the sons/daughters of employees of Pay Group III and 10 scholarships to be awarded to sons/daughters of Pay Group IV employees in the regions of Western Maharashtra, Vidarbha and Marathwada.

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One scholarship in respect of sons and daughters of Pay Gr. III employees and 2 scholarships in respect of sons and daughters of Pay Gr. IV employees in each region are primarily reserved for the candidates belonging to scheduled caste/ scheduled tribes, taking higher education after SSC, irrespective of the marks obtained by them and in case such candidates are not available, the same will be awarded to others as per merit list prepared on the basis of the applications received.

The Departmental/Sectional Heads in Head Office and all the Field officers and the officers of the Labour Section are requested to bring the above amended provisions to the notice of all the employees and also give suitable publicity.
