ADMINISTRATIVE CIRCULAR NO. 210 DATE 10/02/2009

Sub: Providing employment to the dependent of deceased 'Veej Sevak'

appointed under the provision of G.O.162(P) dt.15/03/2005.

Ref: G.O.No.162(P) dated 15/03/2005.

The scheme of voluntary retirement for the Line staff on health ground and providing employment to their wards as 'Veej Sevak' was introduced vide G.O.162(P) dt.15/03/2005. However, in absence of clear provisions regarding employment to the dependents of deceased 'Veej Sevak', the issue regarding extending the coverage of such cases in the scheme of providing employment on compassionate grounds to dependents of deceased employee as per Appendix – 'G' of MSEB Classification and Recruitment Regulations 1961, was under consideration sometime in the past.

- 2. Now, the Managing Director in consultation with Director(Finance) and Director(Operations) has accorded approval to add the following provision as 2(a) below the existing Rule 2 of Appendix-'G' of MSEB Classification and Recruitment Regulations 1961.
- 2(a) "This scheme shall also cover the cases of dependents of the Veej Sevak who met with fatal accident while on duty or who met with non-fatal accident while on duty and declared permanent total disablement for employment and whose services are terminated declaring him invalidated from the services."
- 3. The pending cases if any, shall be finalised as per above provision.
- 4. The other terms and conditions mentioned therein G.O.162(P) dt.15/03/2005 and Appendix-'G' of MSEB Classification and Recruitment Regulations 1961, shall remain unchanged.
