

CORRECTION SLIP NO. 25 DT. 20.04.98
[To G.O.74(P) dt.30.4.74]

Sub: Grant of higher grade benefit to the request transferee on IInd occasion.


PREAMBLE

As per the existing Rule 4 appended to G.O.74 dt.30.4.74, the employees who are transferred at their own request and who have forgone their seniority agreeing to be last in their seniority list, are not entitled to promotion (Higher grade benefit under G.O.74) till the persons next above him is given promotion (Higher grade benefit). At the time of introducing G.O.74, the concept of IInd benefit was not in existence and therefore the provision under Rule 4 was restricted only to the 1st benefit. After introducing the provision of IInd benefit, it was considered necessary to make a rule for the employees after having been granted 1st benefit at his original place of posting and transferred at his own request at the new place of posting. The question of counting 9 years from the date of joining at the new place of posting for grant of higher grade benefit on IInd occasion in such cases, was under consideration for some time in the past.

2. In exercise of the powers delegated to him vide Rule 7 of the rules appended to G.O.74 dt.30.4.74, the Chairman has accorded approval to incorporate a new rule as Rule 4-A below the existing Rule 4 as under:

"4-A The employee who is transferred at his own request by forgoing the seniority in the parent Circle/Division and got the 1st higher grade benefit in the parent Circle/Division, he would be entitled to higher grade benefit on IInd occasion from the date when an employee immediate senior to him becomes due or from the date of completion of 9 years to be reckoned from the date of joining in the new Circle/Division whichever is earlier."

3. The above Correction Slip shall be effective with immediate effect. The clarification/instructions contrary to the above provision, issued in the past shall stand superseded.
